Do No Harm and Conflict Sensitive Programming was hosted by CCC with the financial supports from Bread for the World (BfdW) who is concerned about the impacts of NGO’s work on local conflict. Do No Harm (DNH) is one of the key working approaches of CCC’s Governance Hub Program (GHP) 2017-2021.

Do No Harm Training of Trainers (ToT) will need two staff members (at least one at senior management level) from each NGO which plan to do the full course on DNH for 5-day. After the ToT course, the applicant has to develop action plan to conduct application workshop within their owned project/programming of the organization. In order to conduct the application workshop, the applicant needs to discuss with management level of the organization and gets support from the Executive Director.

The applicant organization and management team will reflect on the current situation and operation of the organization and mainstream Do No Harm in the strategic plan and monitoring plan of the organization or program aim at increasing conflict sensitivity of the organization’s intervention.

The applicant must have full attendance for 5-day Training of Trainer course from 17th to 21st September 2018, in Phnom Penh. Certificate will be awarded to those who attend the full 5 days of training.
