Strengthening Civil Society for Democratic and Sustainable Development
in Cambodia
14 June 2017, Cambodiana Hotel, Phnom Penh

1. Summary of the Project

The Cooperation Committee for Cambodia is implementing a project on “Strengthening civil society for democratic and sustainable development in Cambodia”. The project budget in the amount of 1.5 million Euro is jointly financed by the European Union (EU) and the Bread for the World (BfdW) for the period of 42 months, starting from 01 April 2017.

Aiming at promoting the enabling environment for civil society in Cambodia as well as to strengthen their capacity towards sustainable development in the country, CCC has carefully designed this project by putting it through inclusive consultation and integrating the best possible innovative interventions which can maximize the achievement of the project’s objectives.

The overall objectives of the project are divided two folded: 1). Enhanced effectiveness and impact of civil society organizations (CSOs); and 2). Improved enabling environment for CSOs. In more details, the project has three specific objectives: 1). Increased capacity of CSOs in responding innovatively to development challenges; 2). Improved multi-stakeholder partnership in policy development and effective development cooperation at all levels; and 3). Improved active participation of CCC members and innovative services of the CCC secretariat.

2. Summary of the Project Launching

The project launching will be participated by around 120 people from various institutions and sectors. These include the government, the development partners, the civil society organizations, the private sector and the media.

The event will be conducted on 14 June, at the Cambodiana Hotel, Phnom Penh. In general, the project launching has three objectives:

- To officially launch and promote visibility of the project
- To introduce interventions of the project to its key stakeholders
- To promote collaboration and commitment of key stakeholders towards achieving the project objectives

Aside from the launching ceremony, the event will also integrate two key agenda which include 1). The multi-stakeholder dialogue on inclusive partnership for effective development cooperation; and 2). The group discussion on the collaboration and communication modality for the project.
