<p>1- Welcome and opening remark By Ms. Sin Putheary, ED of CCC</p>	<p>Welcome and opening remarks</p> <p>She provides warmly welcome and thanks for participation, and then mention about the situation now everyone is tracking on Covid-19, especially on zone coloring (Red, Orange, and Yellow).</p> <p>She mentions certain progress of CCC works in the last four months, including effort and support to members and CSOs partners as well as provincial networks. She detailed certain things such as official letter for delay of submission report to MoI as well as letter for LANGO amendment and also submit to MoEF for report delay, other letter submitted to MoFa and MoH for members' vaccination request for members organization so on. English information update on Covid-19 for foreign group organizations who difficult access to Khmer language.</p> <p>CCC keep forward on monitoring on some law, which effect to implement of the CSOs as the whole. LANGO: CCC coordinating with other NGOs to provide inputs to the legal aspect in some of article for the amendment to make it better.</p> <p>The monitoring for CSDGs indicators which now five years pass. Professional standard for CSOs including Global referent standards. CSOs take apart facilitation and also monitoring all of CSDGs indicators.</p> <p>For partnership work, CCC had processed of renew MoU with provincial networks as well as building partnering work with other key national platforms (Add more).</p> <p>Thanks to all our donors and funding partners in continue support for CSOs and always hearing and convey the concerns and suggestions for further discussion with key stakeholders, especially government. Thanks our members for all supports both financial and inputs for better addressing the issues and better enabling environment.</p> <p>Finally, she encourages our members to fill the quick survey for covid-19 impacts, which we can later learnt with the result all together, and thanks again for all participation and then open the meeting.</p>
<p>2- Update legal compliance By Mr. Ry Sovanna, Legal and Policy Manager of CCC</p>	<p>Update on legal compliance for CSOs:</p> <p>There are two laws: state of emergency law but we don't implement it yet, and Covid-19 law which response to the current spread of community event. The key content of key regulation to Covid-19 is related to the control on the business operation, traveling and many other actions. Beside the law, other level of legal regulations also strong for implementation during this period. Then he highlights about the rattan stick that have been show and used by the competent authorities as a threat, which are not respected to international regulations and lead to violent.</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Taxation General Department of Taxation (GDT) have put two optional for tax payers: 1) E-filing and e-payment which could be submit documents and made the e-payment for both small and medium tax payers. 2) Whilst the small tax payers could apply or if they cannot, the small payers could made in handy with scan and attached for tax payment. However, during the lockdown the tax had been delayed for activities which under the restriction field until 15 May 2021. Call center 1277 is workable for any online tax inquiry with GDT. Moreover, he highlights about Covid-19 impacts survey also include this inquiry to learn about the services of GDT. • NSSF The payment and report had been delayed without any charge but it is necessary to get quick process after the end of the lockdown. However, it is not officially notified it will be delayed by when. For call center to any inquiry with NSSF, dial 1286 which now properly operate. • Lockdown regulation The government had been null the social security support for lockdown areas related to affected by Covid-19, especially on monetary support. <p>Question and Answer Q1: Use rattan stick, does it violation to human rights? A1: Cambodian endorses the regulations for human rights and other regulations and violations with clear evident, it could file the complaint to deal with the case. The lockdown regulations had clear mentions which it can follow rather than use any actions or emerge of violence. <p>3-Psychological support during COVID-19 By Mr. Ros Saray Endeth, Project Coordinator of Transcultural Psychosocial Organization (TPO)</p>	<p>Presentation on Mental impact during COVID-19: “There would no physical health without psychosocial health” He highlights three main objectives in the presentation as the context of emotional and psychological issue, impacts of Covid-19, and how to better deal. The psychological issue is not the issue as human being we always emerge with emotional issues. For those had good psychological health, they could work well and support to other beneficiaries.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If we stay positive with love and stay with goal, we would enjoy to manage and deal with the situation and affect to our psychosocial health. • Further, we need good perform with our neighbor which also affected our psychological health. • Identify and limit our needs will impacts to our psychological as well. <p>Impacts of Covid-19 on psychological health: Everyone impacts from Covid-19 on our health which result from the loss of people, traveling restriction, and other basic rights. The impacts could be affected in two patterns: 1) which affect both physical and mental health, and 2) which affect to socio-economical status. Any affect would have reaction from our emotional, which cause to our feeling of boring to stay at home, concern of food and income, fear of infection, and many other feeling. Those emotional also affected to our physical health reaction such as tension of breath, some pain on muscles and some panic. Therefore, it should better control and logical thinking, it could relief and turn into the common situation, and avoid the turning into tension. To much attention and spending time on information could cause more tension, it could affect to our daily work, therefore, we could thinks about some simply work in housework or cheer with family members as well as some actively exercises. Food is another key issues which affected from our emotion, therefore, there should be more with good food. Sleeping is another key factor which affect to our sleep. Meditation is also important that could support to control the tension and emotion by simply trying to control and concentration to our breath. Express the sympathetic is really important that everyone needs during this difficult situation.</p>

Question and Answer

Q1: How to identify light and server psychological issue? And how to deal server psychological issue?

A1: There three principals of measuring: 1 could do regular work and other task as well as could deal tension which we common stay with them. We can deal and support to other neighbor and community. The level of server psychological issue depend on the impacts such as loss of people/things you love. If it could be deal with six months, it become more difficulty.

Q2: With many task during this satiation of work from home, look children with their work, and other task, how to better deal with such difficult emotion?

A2: If we have better emotion, we could deal all the issues. We thinks positively all of those issues. Stress is not an illness but commonly happen to human being, but we need to control and deal with the tension. If it keep longer and always stay without solution it could cause into illness. Play is important for the child age that need to accept and try to control in all mode of violent since shouting and anger expression.

Q3: If the list of psychological test could be shared?

A3: It would be better to get through the consultation first before testing as it is related to the interpretation of the test of the results.

Q4: If TPO have project within the lockdown areas?

A4: we have only in Battambang, Tbong Khmom and Siem Reap for consultation, but you can get hotline consultation.

Finally, he expects that participants could learn something about this psychological health and consider as important agenda for your office and daily life.

Look after Mental Health during Covid-1

4- Measures to prevent the spread of Covid -19
By H.E Dr. Ly Sovann, Advisor and Head of the Department of Infectious Diseases of the Ministry of Health

Measures to prevent the spread of Covid -19

He express his delight to participate to share in this meeting. First, he would like to give some update about Covid-19, which before 20 February community event is well controlled but due to the case of escape which affect to the hotel, mostly foreigners and then spread to the community level and family members. It spread from Phnom Penh, to Kandal, to Presh Sihanouk and to other provinces. There are thousand dots had been drop into the map in the Cambodia as the spread sing. Now there are 82 persons died, and having more cases which difficult to place for the treatment. There are other suspected cases of affected than the real number results from the test, therefore, having decision to lockdown to control the spread. However, it also difficult which could be learn from other countries while more number of household stay together with positive case could affected during lockdown that need to take strong attention.

There are four groups which key targets: 1) Common market, 2) Garment worker, 3) Crowd of foreigners i.e. Casino, 4). Doctor, and beside the four group is hotspot group.

Each provinces, beside treatment center there are other actions such as: 1) placing for positive without system and low symptom, 2) for those directly affected with positive for test, 3) Indirect affected with positive case.

All of Cambodia's 82 reported deaths occurred this year:

- Age range: 24-86 (Median: 57)
- Confirm (+) after death: 15-82 (18%)
- Died on arrival: 14-82 (17%)
- (31%) reported at least one underlying condition

There are 31% of dead have chronic disease.

Existing surveillance systems to monitor the situation:

- EBS:
 - Report of contact travelling to avoid quarantine through media monitoring
 - No reports or signals through 115 or media of large event missed

We have spread based prevalent through suspect from the hotline which we have about 3,000 persons, but now increase about 20,000.

- ILI & SARI sentinel surveillance and pneumonia surveillance
- Exit certificate screening can get information of affection and sometime getting from abroad.
- Exported cases
- Limited asymptomatic screening

Commonly there are three stages for pattern of infection: Stage1: Import case, Stage 2: Community case with small number, and Stage3: Longer life of community infection. We are at stage 2, which commonly found in Phnom Penh and Presh Sihanouk, and later than spread to other provinces. However, most of other provinces is in stage 1.

C3 (close door, close contact, crowded) is the prioritize to pay strong attention areas.

Other key activities is looking for other cluster through the symptom and follow the prevention guide and “three do & three don’t” prevention guide. Other efforts is to get ready for hospitalize and ICU, and both Rapid Test and PCR test.

Covid-19 Master Plan a framework for action preparedness:

- Incident management, planning, administration and coordination
 - Daily EOC meeting with 25 PHD activated: Since 20 Feb community Event, CDC conduct meeting every day at 9:00am, which at least 176 meeting conducted.
 - Strengthen provincial capacity for using EOC/IMS and multisource surveillance for risk assessment and decision making.
- Laboratory
 - < 97, 000 test conducted since Feb 19, which now we found from UK Varian. And now we found Indian Varian for Indonesian but well control and prevention of traveling from Indian and other related cases.
 - Genomic Sequencing –B.1.1.7 importation event
 - Serology- RT-PCR negative links
 - Support and sustain existing diagnostics labs
- Surveillance and risk assessment
 - Identifying 3C setting and new clusters for prioritized investigation
 - MOH visited/visiting health centers in the affected provinces to review ILI data and support detection efforts by coordinating specimen collection of ILI patients.
- Healthcare delivery, pathways, cost and financial protection
 - MOH is conduction the readiness check of clinical management for large scale community transmission.
 - MOH DHS is finalizing version 3.0 of the clinical guidelines.
- Non-pharmaceutical public health
 - 1st layer- 3 Do and 3 don’t (implemented national-wide)
 - 2nd layer- Limit social gathering
 - 3rd layer- Restriction of movements
- Community engagement
 - 3C alert announcements, high risk group call for testing, quarantine do’s and don’ts.
 - NCHP is revising Covid-19 booklet for VHSG, CCWG and village chiefs to include information about vaccines, which will be disseminated nation-wide)
- Strategic communications
 - MOH and other ministries continues to issue notification on NPIs and strengthening Covid-19 measures
 - MOH counties to issue 3C hotspot update in four languages (Khmer, English, Chinese, and Vietnamese)
- Operational logistics and financing
 - Support all 7 seven focus areas in procurement of equipment, reagents, PPE, and other supplies
 - Incentives for HVWs, RRTs, quarantine officer

- Increase efficiencies in health sector to preserve funding

Question and Answer

Q1: For better channel for collaboration and support?

A1: UN is the chair and could channel. Moreover, CDC is open the door to make any collaboration and any level of support to combat with the issues. Now we need staff with data entry, which now more than 10 000 case need entry. Need IT to control the database system as well, especially within the key provincial levels, which could communicate directly to provincial levels. Every meeting from 9:00am are open for observation and support. For community need education and support to the quarantine people as well as control on the data of these groups. Education and dissemination within community is also import to encourage and refer them/case for the expert. Sanitation and materials is also important to manage and support. For provincial level, can directly community with provincial authorities or any IT can communicate directly to provincial department is fine.

Q2: How the meeting can be joint with CDC and provincial department?

A2: Provincial department have setting up the meeting room, and could get the link from each provinces.

Finally, he express that though we try hard so far, but community spread had started and it could be infected all the time, therefore, it need serious preventions and get vaccination. This prevention and action need all participation.
