



She comprehends social protection and social services like monthly financial aid, healthcare, vaccinations, and health examinations at no cost, particularly during pregnancy, childbirth, and for children under 2 years old. She mentioned that when her family fell sick, they would visit the health center and referral hospital on January 16 in Preah Vihear province. Even though she utilized the equity card (ID Poor Card), she noticed that doctors treated her family with the same care as any other patient. She mentioned that prior to obtaining the Equity Card, her family struggled with everyday life, but after receiving it, their family situation improved.

She urges the Government to keep assisting those in need, as this aid has truly improved the lives of the underprivileged and advocated for a transparent method to distribute funds to the people. Because some individuals currently receive varying benefits, despite having the same family circumstances and comparable living standards.

Case Study: Benefits of Social Assistance

Ms. Leang Veng, 28 years old, belongs to the Kui ethnic group and resides in Preah Vihear Province. She has a daughter and two sons. Her spouse works in construction. Her first son has been paralyzed since birth; the second daughter is in primary school, while the youngest has not started school yet.

Currently, she resides with a family of nine, which includes her single mother and an uncle. Underdeveloped fitness (stunted), along with two younger siblings and a sister. She works as a farmer and laborer within the community.
