

Workshop on Digital Registration System for Domestic NGOs and Associations

I. Introduction

On 16 July 2025, the Ministry of Interior (MoI) issued an official notification letter announcing the launch of a Digital Registration System for Domestic Non-governmental Organizations (NGOs) and Associations. This initiative responds directly to recommendations made by Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) during the 6th Government–CSO Partnership Dialogue held on 11 December 2024, where CSOs advocated for the establishment of an online platform to facilitate registration, organizational updates, and document submission.

The newly introduced digital system is currently in a six-month trial phase, applicable initially for new registrations of Domestic NGOs and Associations. This digital transition represents a significant shift in how civil society organizations interact with government systems and brings potential benefits in terms of efficiency, accessibility, and transparency.

There are questions from CSO members of CCC concerning the application of the digital registration and what are the CSOs should be aware of. To ensure that CSOs fully understand the Notification and the functionality of the new system, CCC will organize a dedicated workshop to provide clarification and allow for direct dialogue between CSOs and MoI representatives.

Objectives

- To inform CSOs about the content and implications of the MoI Notification.
- To provide a platform for CSOs to understand about the features, procedures, and requirements of the new digital registration system.
