THEORY OF CHANGE



PROTECTION, WELLBEING, INCLUSION

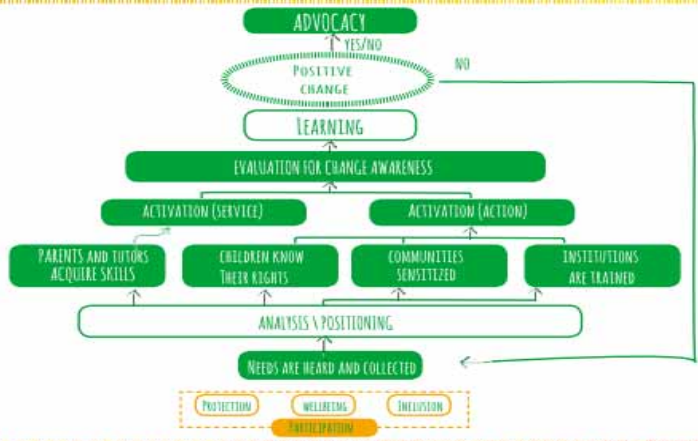
Children in the communities where CIAI works are safe and live in a positive and caring family environment. They go to school and have access to educational opportunities. They are in good conditions and happy and are the leaders of their own lives.

THE CHANGE

- AWARENESS PARTICIPATION**
Participates in signaling distress, understands that the situation can change, participates in the definition and implementation of the process. The child recognizes the change. He/she increases the knowledge about his/her rights and duties.
- RESPONSIBILITY RESILIENCE**
Can recognize the vulnerability, exercise positively its parental responsibility, participates in the process, it is prepared and satisfied for it. Acquire resilience capacity.
- PERMEABILITY ACTIVATION**
Recognizes and reports vulnerability. Has an active role to secure children's rights, participates in defining the criteria for monitoring and taking in charge, including the diversity and supporting the child. Improves its resilience.
- INCLUSIVENESS PROGRAMMING**
Recognize the vulnerability, are inclusive and participative, they know how to prevent vulnerabilities and are able to offer adequate services and suitable for children. Implement children rights.

CHILDREN'S PARTICIPATION
Children should be engaged in a continuous process of expression and active involvement at different levels in all decisions that affect them.

CHILDREN ARE LEADERS OF CHANGE, NOT ONLY BENEFICIARIES



FAMILIES, COMMUNITIES AND INSTITUTIONS CAN MAKE THE CHANGE POSSIBLE, BUT THEY NEED TO CHANGE THEMSELVES

INPUT

CAPABILITIES
Change requires expertise and experience in terms of knowledge and proximity to the communities and countries where CIAI works, and appropriate intervention models.

LONG-TERM INTERVENTIONS
The change requires a systemic approach that is deployed in a long-term commitment with the communities and countries in which CIAI intervenes.

REASONING
It is necessary to develop a reasoning in order to support the change.

THE PROBLEM

The most vulnerable children, who do not have adequate protection, psycho-emotional well-being and opportunities for social inclusion, cannot fully develop their potential because they do not enjoy their rights and cannot perform their duties.

Social inclusion: student councils promoting change in their schools

Support the functioning of student council with specific focus on:

- Awareness regarding child labour in Siem reap
- school environment and quality standard in Pailin
- Child protection and school drop out in Prey Veng, Svay rieng, Kampong Chnang and Pursat



Protection: community, parents and child feel supported to decrease child abuse and exploitation

Team of social workers regularly meet parents of child at risk

Close collaboration with CCWC

Andong centre for children outside school time

Increase parents and community awareness about child rights in Siem Reap



Care: guarantee child well being

A team of educators, social workers and nurse provide key support to children of Andong

Social workers meet with child regularly provide health support

Mobile clinic in Mondulkiri ensure regular health check of children from remote villages

Nutrition is improved with breakfast and lunch at Andong centre and monitoring and nutrition training in Mondulkiri
