Background

KAWP is a Cambodian Association established by OSB (Overseas Service Bureau). OSB had implemented a project, called Re-establishment of Khmer Community in Batambang province, from 1992 to 1995. The main activities of this project were focusing on solving communities' challenges and strengthening Khmer staff's capacity in managing their own organization. After Khmer staff being able to manage their own project, OSB assisted this team to transform themselves into a local NGO which is called KAWP, registered with Ministry of Interior on 15th March 1995, Renewal on 06 December 2017. KAWP is a not-for-profit association, non-partisan, non-racial or religion established to serve the benefit of people living in remote area.

General vision

A peaceful society, people live contentedly, exercise freedom, better life condition full of dignity.

Mission

KAWP cooperates with relevant institutions to support community's potentiality to be truly self-led development.

Target beneficiaries would have better food security and gaining more incomes by active participation in sustainable community organizing.

Organizational Structure

The organization structure consists of level, which are Board of Directors, Executive Management Committee and Staff. The organization shall be governed by a Board. The Board shall be composed of seven members, including the following officers: Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Treasurer and four members-at-large. Executive Management Committee (EMC) consists of three members (at least one female or male), who are Liaison Coordinator, Admin and Finance Coordinator, and Educational & Village Project Coordinator. EMC have a rotation role amongst members with the mandate of 3 years. Number of staff implementing and supporting the project can be varied according to actual needs.

Implementation:

Since the beginning of Krom Akphiwat Phum, up to now it is 9th phases. Recently, Krom is implementing the program called Sustainable Community Empowerment. (2017-2019) with support from *Bread for the World*, Communities and *SADP*.

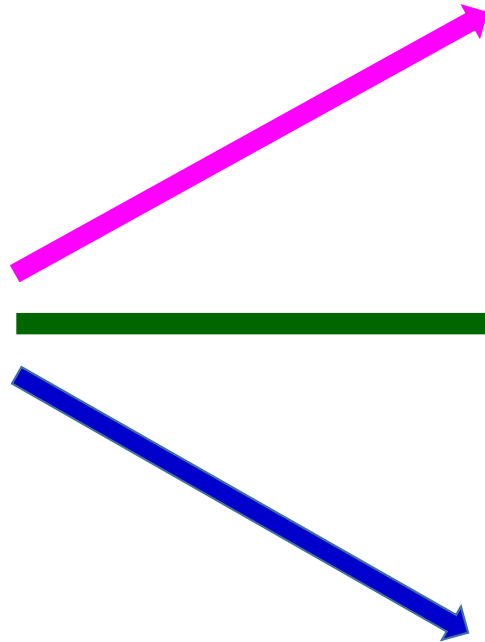

b. Problem Identification. (Village Meeting)

c. Problem Prioritization.

d. Problem analysis

e. Root cause analysis (Problem tree).

f. Solution

g. *Project Implementation*

- ii. Select committee/setup role and responsibility.
- iii. Create purpose.
- iv. Writing background
- v. Describe problem faced and root cause.
