

organizations who completed DNH Application Workshop were able to identify new approaches of their project's implementation through practical exercise. 50% among 43 organizations have incorporated the DNH framework into their project proposal and project plan, and 65% of them transferred DNH concept to their other team and community leaders through meeting and training at the target community.
