- Estimated as 180 NGOs are working on general health in Cambodia
- 96 identified NGOs are working related health, (63 local, 3 companies, and 29 international)
- 33 NGOs on MCHN, 44 NGOs on CD, 21 NGOs on NCD and 25 NGOs on Health system strengthening
- 6 partners (BC, CNPUD, NEWN/Smart Girl, WNU, KORSANG, CPN+)
- 20 Development partners
- HACC Strategic Plan 2018-2020 and **being developed for 2021-2025**
- **Membership under reviewed and Membership fee being collected**

3. Challenges during COVID-19

- Delta complication
- Difficulty to access in health facilities
- Majority losing of jobs and incomes
- Increases of illness and mental health
- Still high risk of infection importation
- High risk of large scale community transmission
- Lack of coordination and participation from NGO at national level

Solutions

- **Whole-of-Government Whole-of-society approach:**
 - Enhanced partnership with relevant stakeholders, including private sectors, CSOs, NGOs to ensure timely and effective public health and social response
- **Timely adjustment of Public Health measures**
- **Enhancing readiness in preparation of large scale community transmission**
 - Update the response plans in all areas (surveillance, lab, RCCE, clinical management, OSL) using lessons learnt from recent experiences
 - Identify or develop guidance and SOPs for safe reopening
- **Continue to expand vaccination:**
 - Available evidence suggests protection by vaccination against severe diseases or death
- **Balance the interests of health and the economy** in COVID-19 response efforts
