I. Introduction

Cooperation Committee for Cambodia (CCC) is the largest and longest membership-based organization in Cambodia. By August of 2023, CCC has 177 NGOs, foreign and domestic NGOs as its members and provincial NGO networks in 16 provincial NGO networks.
