CCC has been playing a significant role in civil society since 1990s. CCC is currently implementing its fourth phase of Governance Hub Program (GHP 2021-2023). GHP has a vision: sustainable and democratic development in Cambodia, and two main goals: 1) improved enabling environment for CSOs; and 2) sustained functionality of CSO Resource Hub at national and sub national levels.
