Introduction

The Cooperation Committee for Cambodia (CCC) is the leading and longest-established membership organization for local and international NGOs in Cambodia. Since 1990, CCC has played roles as an observer, coordinator, and advocate, aiming to strengthen Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) by providing them with an improved enabling environment and democratic space.

Since 2022, CCC has been part of the Civil Peace Service Project, which aims to enhance the capacity of CSOs in peacebuilding and conflict resolution and foster collaboration among CSOs which are engaged in peace and conflict-sensitive initiatives. As outlined in our strategy under point 6.3. Capacity building on peacebuilding, CCC will support CSOs to build their skills and knowledge in peacebuilding by offering training and learning opportunities. These sessions may be led by member organizations or external trainers.

Peacebuilding is still a relatively new field for many organizations, making this an excellent opportunity to mainstream peace work, share practices, and initiate discussions on how to sustain peace. Our last year’s survey linked to the development of CCC’s Peacebuilding Strategy, involving around 30 CCC member organizations, highlighted the high demand for capacity building in peacebuilding. This exchange of experience will offer a valuable opportunity to explore what peacebuilding entails.

Objectives

- To establish opportunities for member organizations to share and learn diverse approaches and practical insights in peacebuilding.
- To strengthen the cooperation and network among CCC members and other stakeholders regarding peace work.
- To create a space for sharing peace-building initiative, challenges and how we can work together for building peace in communities

Expected Output

Participants will gain a clearer understanding of how various CCC members contribute to peacebuilding. Through presentations and discussions, they will expand their knowledge, share ideas, and develop specific plans to enhance peacebuilding efforts going forward including cooperation with others in this field.
