## CONCEPT NOTE

### CCC MEMBERS 282<sup>ND</sup> BI-MONTHLY MEETING ON "CONSULTATION ON CCC PROGRAM STRATEGY (2027-2030) AND CONSOLIDATED INPUTS FOR PARTNERSHIP FORUM BETWEEN GOVERNMENT & CSOs"

#### Introduction

Recently, Civil society organizations (CSOs) are under growing pressure. Many are struggling with increasingly uncertain funding, driven by shifting donor priorities and broader economic challenges. These reductions come at a time when CSOs are expected to respond to more complex and urgent needs, stretching already limited resources and placing significant tension on their ability to sustain programs and fulfil their missions. For CSOs in Cambodia, these pressures are intensified. The challenges highlight the need for stronger capacity, closer collaboration, and more forward-looking approaches to ensure that Cambodia's civil society remains resilient and effective in an increasingly uncertain environment.

Facing the growing pressure for CSOs, CCC is proactively shaping its Governance Hub Program Strategy for 2027–2030 to respond to an increasingly uncertain funding landscape and the evolving needs of its members. CCC will bring the Governance Hub Program (GHP) Strategy to its the 282<sup>nd</sup> Bi-Monthly Meeting on 22 May 2026 for structured consultation. This meeting provides an engaging platform to members in a substantive discussion on CCC 2027–2030 strategic direction, ensuring that it is a collective and well-rounded strategy and reflects emerging priorities and especially to make sure the proposed strategies in any levels highly contribute to the need of the members of CCC both short and long-term for sustainable development in Cambodia.

The Bi-Monthly Meeting will also to share the progress of its interventions and officially welcome new members to CCC network and discuss with members on the inputs (what challenges and suggestions that have been raised and update on the support and collaboration from Mol) from CSOs for the upcoming partnership forum with Ministry of Interior (Mol) in order to give a better enabling environment for CSOs within Cambodia to operate their programs with a supportive climate from relevant authorities of all levels. The meeting will bring together senior management from CCC member organizations, including both local and international NGOs to share, discuss and learn from each other.

1. Share achievements and welcome new members of CCC.
2. Discuss and consult with the members of CCC to get the inputs for developing the new Governance Hub Program in the next four-year 2027-2030.
3. Discuss and update inputs for the partnership forum with Mol.
